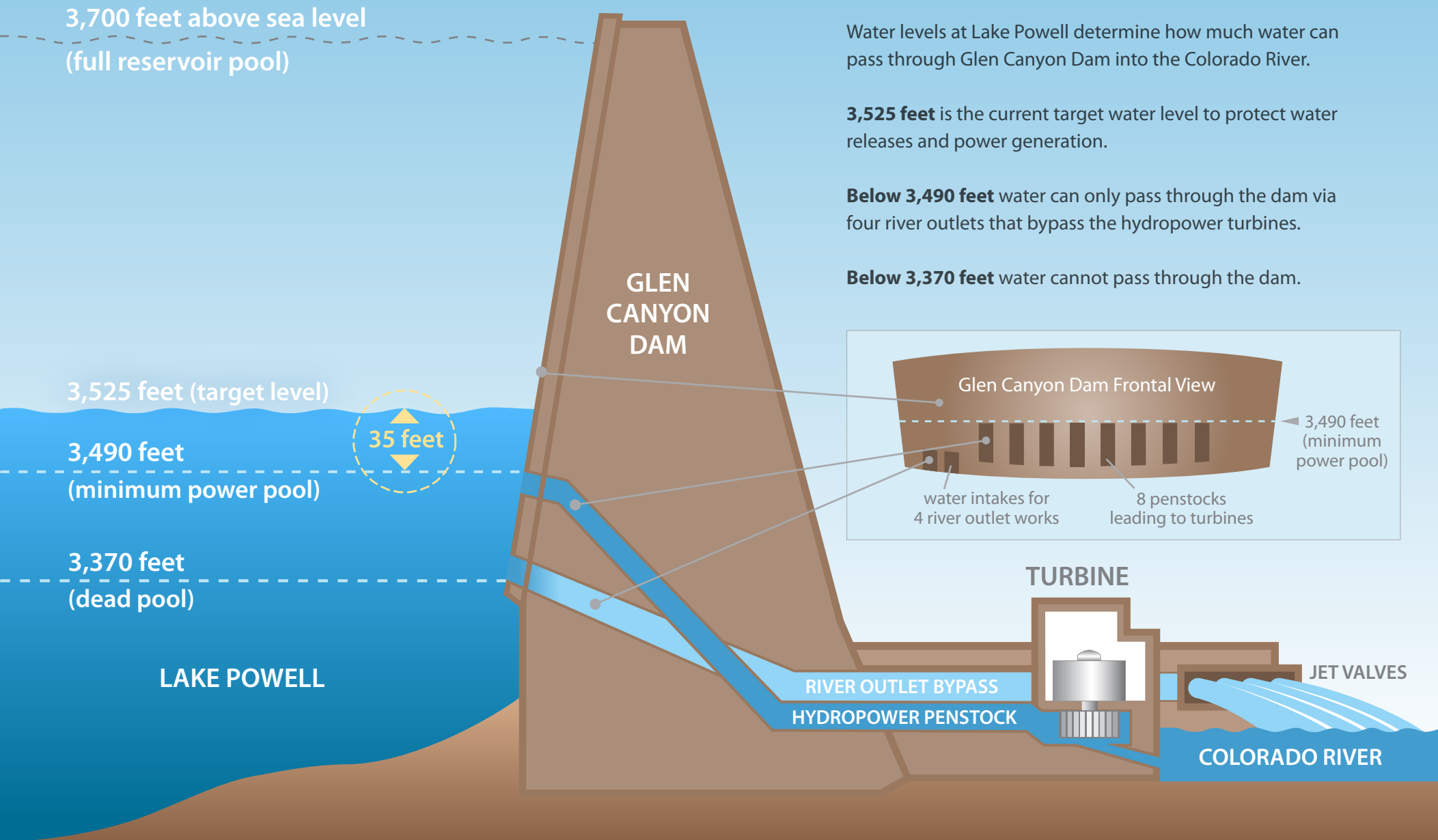


# Lake Powell Critical Water Levels



Water levels at Lake Powell determine how much water can pass through Glen Canyon Dam into the Colorado River.

**3,525 feet** is the current target water level to protect water releases and power generation.

**Below 3,490 feet** water can only pass through the dam via four river outlets that bypass the hydropower turbines.

**Below 3,370 feet** water cannot pass through the dam.
