This represents 34 years in total. The South Project is currently contemplated as a 30-year operating life at full build out. It is important to keep in mind that these are preliminary numbers and subject to change as mine/plant design engineering proceeds. The water supply pipeline and pumping system is being designed to transport the full 15 cfs available under the water right (with adequate turndown capacity for lesser flow rates), as final water demand numbers for the South Project are not yet known. This allows for the utility corridor to only be disturbed for water supply pipeline construction one time, rather than multiple 'builds' of smaller-capacity pipeline systems.
